On 9 August 2015, Bahrain Law No. 9/2015 promulgating the Arbitration Law based on the 2006 UNCITRAL Model Law (the "New Law") came into effect. Whilst the introduction of the New Law is a step forward in unifying international arbitration rules and ensuring Bahrain is an attractive jurisdiction, this conference will focus on the arbitration landscape in Bahrain following the adoption of the New Law. This event will include 2 debates on arbitrator's immunity in the GCC and the application of interim measures in Bahrain.
